

PREAMBLE

Rally New Zealand hereby declare the following Articles to be those governing **2024 BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP**

ARTICLE 1 - INTERPRETATION

In these Articles the following expressions shall have the meanings set out:

- "The Series" means the BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP and
- "The Convenors" means those administering the Series. The Convenors consists of 3 appointed officers from Rally New Zealand, promoters of the NZRC and
- "Round Organiser" means the MotorSport NZ member clubs organising a Rally which is a round of the NZRC and
- "MotorSport NZ" means MotorSport New Zealand Incorporated and
- o "Round" means each rally, the results of which qualify for points in the SCHOLARSHIP.

ARTICLE 2 - OBJECTIVE

To promote and encourage competitors, from all regions, to participate in a series within an enjoyable and relaxed competition in the spirit of motor sport.

ARTICLE 3 - ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 TEAMS.
 - 3.1.1 All drivers / co-drivers in the BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP must be a current financial member of any MotorSport NZ Member club and must satisfy the entry requirements of each Round Organiser.
 - 3.1.2 To qualify for the **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** points, the drivers / codrivers must register their intention to compete in the series with the conveners and can reside in any region of New Zealand.
 - 3.1.3 Drivers must be under the age of 30 [THIRTY] as at the 31st December 2024.
- 3.2 VEHICLES & VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY
- 3.2.1 All vehicles must comply with the specifications set out in the current MotorSport Manual Appendix Two, Schedule A. The following rules will be recognized for the **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** cars that comply with CAT 2, CAT 3 & CAT5B of the NZRC.
- 3.2.2 Class eligibility will be at the sole discretion of the conveners and any enquiries regarding eligibility should be referred to the NZRC conveners, Carl Fenn, Blair Bartels or Simon Bell
- 3.2.3 It will be the competitors' responsibility to ensure that their car is the correct as per the rules in 3.2 above. The conveners will at times do a compliance audit on the cars, any cars found to have illegal modifications, will be disgualified and all points lost.

ARTICLE 4 - SERIES STRUCTURE

- 4.1 The 2024 **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** shall comprise of the SIX Rounds of the 2024 New Zealand Rally Championship
- 4.2 The 2024 **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** will be held on DAY ONE of a two day event only to enable the inclusion of CAT5B.

ARTICLE 5 - SERIES PERSONNEL

At each Round, the convenors will be represented by the following personnel who shall have the responsibilities and authority set out:

(1) SERIES CONVENORS

Carl Fenn / Blair Bartels / Simon Bell

Who shall have the authority of a Series Convener who is responsible for and authorised on the Series behalf to:

- (a) Deal with all administration matters pertaining to the Series and
- (b) Record and publish all Series points schedules and

- (c) Liaise with Round Organisers on all matters pertaining to these Articles and
- (d) Ensure correct placement of decals on vehicles contesting the Series and
- (e) Act in the capacity as a Competitor Relations Officer (as detailed in National Sporting Code Article 88) for the Series competitors and
- f) Shall be responsible for receiving and recording Series Registrations

(2) SERIES TECHNICAL ELIGIBILITY

Carl Fenn / Blair Bartels / Simon Bell

Who shall have the authority of a Technical Eligibility Officer who is responsible for and authorised on the Series behalf to:

(a) Deal with all matters pertaining to eligibility

ARTICLE 6 - SERIES ENTRY / REGISTRATION

6.1 DRIVERS

- 6.1.1 Registration for the **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** is to be made by Drivers on the form provided with these Articles.
- 6.1.2 Competitors MUST register for the **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** 2 weeks prior to the start of the 1st round of the NZRC
- 6.1.3 Entry fee is FREE, but competitors must be registered for their respective class of the 2024 NZRC.
- 6.1.4 It is the responsibility of the competitor to obtain the necessary entry forms.
- 6.1.5 By entering the **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP**, all drivers and co-drivers agree to comply under these Articles.

ARTICLE 7 - DETERMINATION OF THE SERIES

7.1 Number of Rounds

The **BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP** shall comprise of 6 Rounds. Competitors' points from all 6 rounds will count. The convenors reserve the right to either cancel or amend any Rounds due to force majeure without affecting in any way, its power to award any title.

7.2 Points

Points, based on Series Stage Placings in each Stage at each Round, will be allocated to the Driver.

7.3 Determination of Ties

- 7.3.1 Should a 'dead heat' occur in any Round of the Series the points allocated to the position 'dead heated' and the next following positions in the Rally will be added together and equally divided between the competitors concerned.
- 7.3.2 In the event of a 'tie' in the final points tally of the Series for any placing, the best placing shall be determined by reference the greater number of higher Series stage placings, by placing, achieved at all Rounds. (e.g. the number of 1st places, then the number of 2nd places etc.)
- 7.3.3 In the event that the previous paragraphs above prove ineffective in deeming a winner, then the Conveners shall, after taking into account such considerations as they deem to be desirable, either declare a winner or declare two or more competitors (as may be appropriate) to be the equal winners of the Series.

ARTICLE 8 - AWARDS

- 8.1 Titles Drivers
 - 8.1.1 The BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP Overall Winning Driver will receive:
 - (i) The BRIAN GREEN JUNIOR RALLY SCHOLARSHIP Trophy
 - (ii) FREE ENTRY into the 2025 NZRC
 - (iii) FREE ENTRY to Rally Whangarei 2025
 - (iv) **SUPPLIED WITH** 10 x MRF tyres

ARTICLE 9 - DECALS

9.1 All cars must run the compulsory New Zealand Rally Championship decals as per the portfolio.

ARTICLE 10 - DISPUTES

- 10.1 The conveners are charged with interpreting and making decisions on the series articles and technical regulations.
- 10.2 Should a registered competitor have a dispute with any of their decisions then the matter will be adjudicated on, by the Disputes Tribunal.
- 10.3 The Tribunal will hear the case in the same manner as that laid down for MotorSport NZ hearings. Their decision will be final.
- 10.4 Should a competitor wish to refer the matter to the Tribunal, it must be done within 1 week of the decision being made. The matter can be referred to any Tribunal member. **The Tribunal consists of: Carl Fenn / Blair Bartels / Simon Bell**
